# HOW TO APPLY?

## LIT APPLICATION PROCESS:

1. Decide on your course: A full list of the available courses can be found at [international.lit.ie/departments](http://international.lit.ie/departments)
2. Complete your application form: The LIT International Application Form can be downloaded from [international.lit.ie/apply-here/](http://international.lit.ie/apply-here/)
3. Submit Application Form: Send your completed application, along with copies of your academic results and English qualifications by email to [international@lit.ie](mailto:international@lit.ie)
4. Applications for a September start should be made before June 1st. Late applications may be considered.

## VISAS

Students from Visa Required countries should allow sufficient time for visa processing – in some cases up to 8 weeks.

# LIT ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

## FIRST YEAR UNDERGRADUATE:

Applicants must achieve suitable grades in a recognised Secondary Education Examination, (equivalent to A-Levels or IB), in order to satisfy LIT entry requirements. A Portfolio is required for all Art & Design programmes.

## ADVANCED ENTRY (ENTRY TO YEAR 2,3 OR 4 OF AN UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMME) & POSTGRADUATE ENTRY:

Applicants must provide:

- Academic Transcripts for all prior education.
- Document showing English Language proficiency.

## ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

IELTS Qualifications	Minimum Level Required
First Year Undergraduate	IELTS 5.5
Advanced Entry Undergraduate (Year 2, 3 or 4)	IELTS 6.0
Postgraduate	IELTS 6.0

**\*NB** Proof of English language capacity other than IELTS (such as TOEFL, Cambridge, etc.) will be considered. Please provide documentary evidence of your scores.

# LIT SCHOLARSHIPS

A limited number of Merit based President's Scholarships of €1000 each are available to international students each year.

Required for consideration in addition to Academic Transcripts:

- Letter of Recommendation (e.g. Academic supervisor, Voluntary Work)
- Personal Statement Letter

Closing date for entry is June 30th.

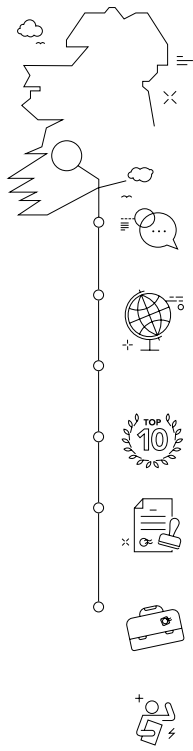
