Accommodation for international students


Accommodation in the Dundalk area is approximately 50% cheaper than the Dublin region. There are a variety of accommodation options available to international students,

* International Foundation Programme (IFP)

The International Foundation programmes prepare international students for direct entry to the first year of an undergraduate degree at DkIT. The DkIT IFP has been developed to help students who have completed their secondary school education and need language and/or academic preparation, to prepare them for Bachelor study.

** Direct Entry

Students who have adequate high school grades and an IELTS score of 5.5/6.0 can obtain direct entry into the first year of their ordinary/honours degree.

*** Advanced Entry

Students who have completed some studies at university and have an IELTS score of 6.0 can obtain advanced entry into the relevant year of their ordinary/honours degree.

Remain in Ireland after Graduation

International students can remain in Ireland after completing their degree to work or seek employment. The period of time allowed is:

- · Honours Degree, (Level 8) 12 months
- Masters Degree, Post Graduate Diploma, PhD (Doctorate) (Level 9/10) - 24 months

Qulification Levels In Ireland
